### Tire Maintenance: 3 Things You Can Do

- Check air pressure monthly with an air gauge.
- Rotate your tires every 5,000 to 8,000 miles.
- Examine the tread on your tires for wear. Try this test: Place a Lincoln penny upside down between the treads and facing you. If you can see the top of Lincoln's head, then it's time for new tires.

### In the U.S. ...

- 1 in 4 cars has at least one tire that is significantly underinflated
- 11,000 tire-related crashes happen each year
- Driving on worn tires at highway speeds in wet conditions increases stopping distance by as much as 87 feet

### In Oklahoma ...

In 2016 weather conditions were a factor in a number of crashes, many related to tire performance:

- Rain: 5,126 crashes
- Snow: 110 crashes
