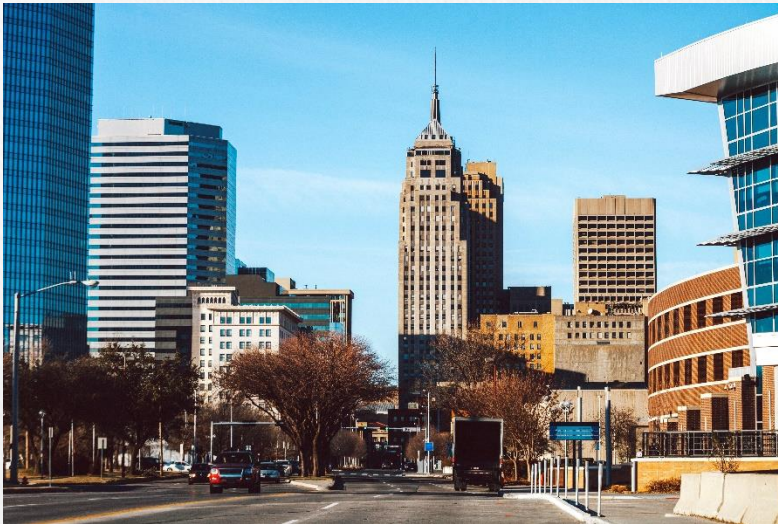

Intersections: Safety Starts with 'S' and Begins with 'U'

T-Bone is for Grilling



- 35% to 40% of crashes in the U.S. are intersection-related
 - Most result from human errors, such as not scanning ahead or misjudging another's speed
 - Head-on and side-impact (T-bone) collisions often result in serious injuries and fatalities
- National Safety Council

Why

Failure to yield to vehicles that have the right of way causes almost every intersection collision

Safety

- Slow down, look both ways
- Use directional signals
- Pay attention to traffic lights
