Fall driving safety tips

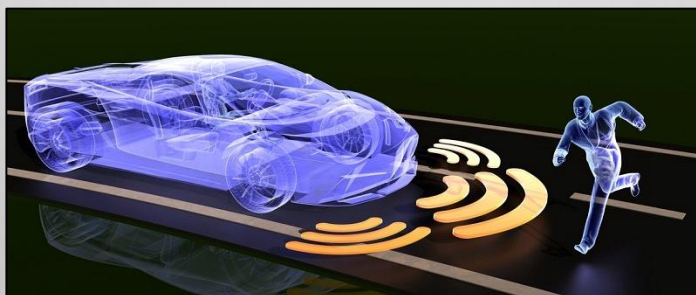
Crashes 'Leave' Big Bruises

When leaves accumulate, the roadway can become wet and slippery.

- Slow down if you are driving on a road covered with leaves, especially while making turns or navigating curves
- Allow yourself plenty of room to stop in an emergency. Keep a greater distance between you and the car in front of you.
- Leaves make it difficult to see potholes and bumps in the road.

Halloween Safety Tips for Motorists

1. Watch for children walking on roadways, medians and curbs
2. Enter and exit driveways and alleys carefully



- October is the beginning of Deer breeding season
- Deer are most active at dawn and dusk, so motorists should be extra-alert driving between 5-8 a.m. and 5-10 p.m.
- 424 crashes involving deer occurred in 2016, according to the Oklahoma Highway Safety Office
