Use of Marijuana Can Put You & Others on the Road at Risk



1. Using marijuana can decrease a driver's focus, impair judgment of time and distance and slow reaction time.
2. From 2007 to 2013, there was a 48% increase in weekend nighttime drivers who tested positive for marijuana.

In Oklahoma, nearly three crashes every day involve drugged driving.

Safety First

- There is no 0.08 BAC equivalent for any drug, including marijuana.
- Unlike alcohol, drug levels do not consistently correlate with specific levels of impairment.
- If you intend to drive, the safest option is not to have any alcohol or drugs in your system
